Mr. Dennis Newby is the chief financial officer and director of Business Management at Idaho National Laboratory (INL). He is also the CFO for Battelle Energy Alliance (BEA), a limited liability company responsible for managing INL for the Department of Energy (DOE). He leads an organization of over 200 staff providing a wide range of business support, including acquisition services, prime contract management, agreements management, project management, business systems, accounting, planning and decision support, and field-deployed business support offices. Mr. Newby has over 30 years of progressive business leadership experience with Battelle Memorial Institute, a nonprofit research and development institution headquartered in Columbus, Ohio.

Prior to joining INL in 2012, Mr. Newby was the director of Business Management at Oak Ridge National Laboratory (ORNL), another DOE multipurpose R&D laboratory in Oak Ridge, Tennessee. At ORNL, he and his team developed and implemented several business and cost model innovations to support the growing mission of the laboratory.

Mr. Newby began his Battelle career at Pacific Northwest National Laboratory (PNNL) in Richland, Washington. He had management and leadership positions in accounting, planning and budgeting, research business management, and contracts. He was instrumental in several business initiatives at PNNL, including business practices associated with its unique use permit contract, which allowed the laboratory to conduct private R&D with government and commercial entities.

Mr. Newby was also the business manager for Battelle's Global Laboratory Operations. In that role, he provided business and financial support to the vice president responsible for management of all Battelle national laboratories, including six DOE laboratories, one Department of Homeland Security laboratory, and one laboratory in the United Kingdom. In this role, he identified and leveraged best business practices across the family of laboratories managed by Battelle.

With his experience across several national laboratories, Mr. Newby has led several peer reviews of business systems and processes at various institutions. He is a member of the PNNL Board of Directors, and the Business and Audit committees at PNNL and Los Alamos National Laboratory.

Mr. Newby has a bachelor's degree in finance from Central Washington University.
